



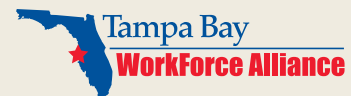

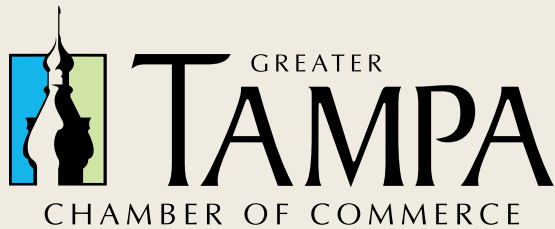

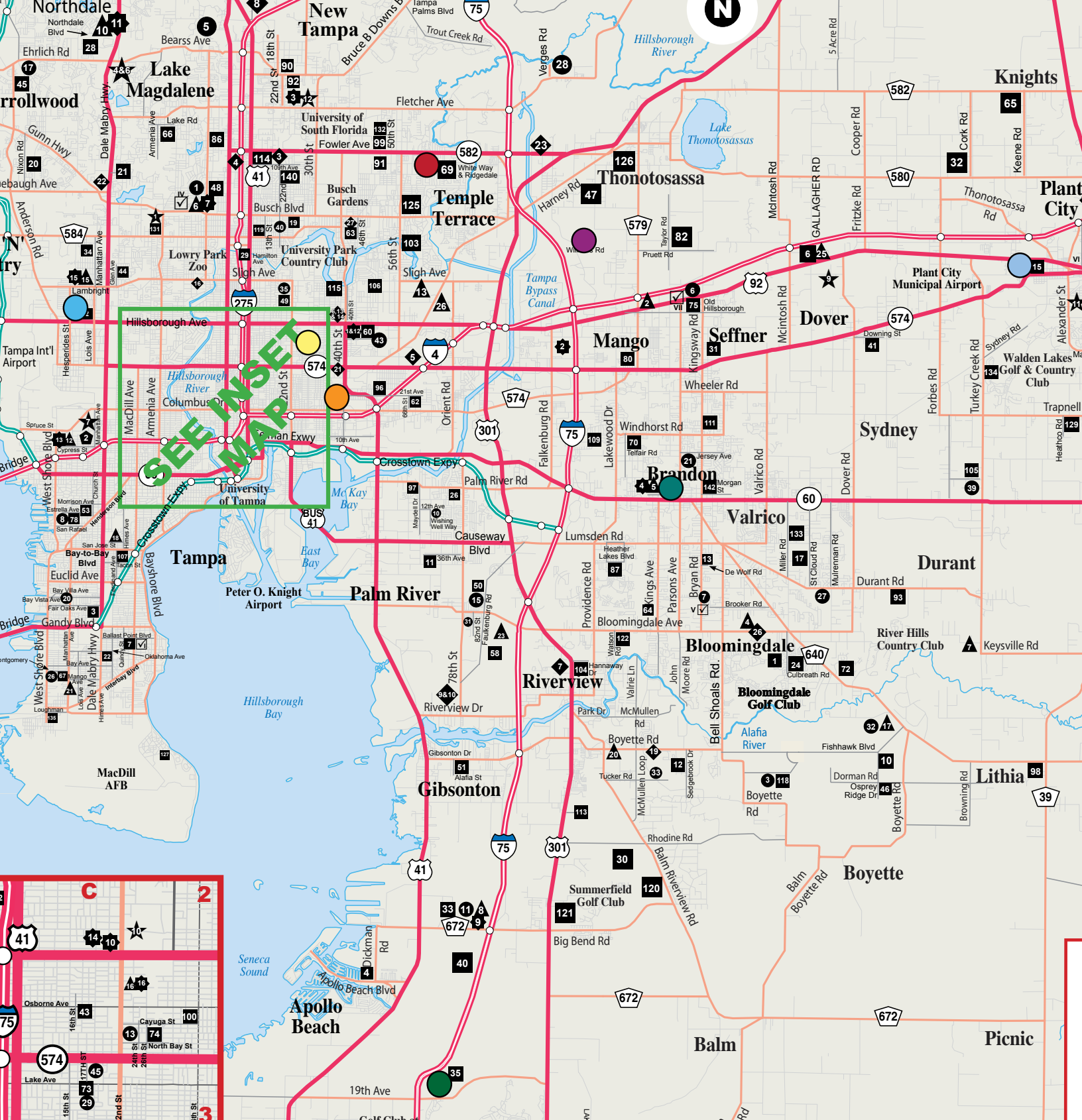
Ferrell, Franklin, Greco, Jennings, McLane, Pierce, Shields and Tomlin Middle Schools
