## **Who can be a Junior Achievement Scholarship Recipient?**

### **Requirements are:**

- participated in Junior Achievement programs between 5-12<sup>th</sup> grade
- obtains a high school diploma or GED
- intends to attend a post-secondary institution
- submits proof of current GPA from an official high school transcript
- submit proof of SAT or ACT scores
- minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5
- completed application essay

### **Application Essay**

Applicants must submit a 800-1000 word essay containing the following information:

- describe yourself as a person
- share the impact that Junior Achievement has had on your personal/academic development
- share the challenges you have had to overcome and how JA helped you overcome them
- the impact that a JA volunteer has had on you
- if you have volunteered for Junior Achievement at various events and/or in the classroom, how many times, the impact that being a Junior Achievement volunteer/student ambassador has had on you
- Why are you deserving of a Junior Achievement Scholarship?
- Share your career goals
